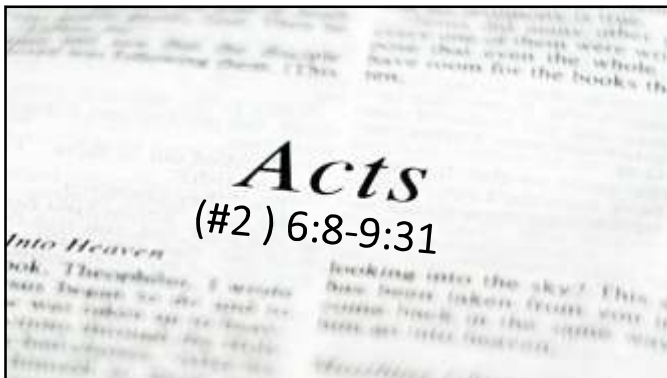
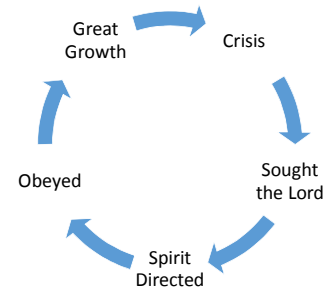

- Prayed for Spirit Baptisms (8:15)
- Encouraged Repentance (8:22)
- Laying on of Hands – Prayer (8:14)
- Requesting Prayer (8:24)
- Blinded Saul Praying (9:11)

- Philip, Spirit Led (8:26)
- Philip, Continued Being Spirit Led (8:29)
- Philip Snatched Away (8:39)
