(1) EVERY WORD MATTERS.

(2) REPETITION, OR "WASTING" WORDS, IS THEREFORE THE PRIMARY TOOL FOR EMPHASIS.

(3) IF THE WRITING IS REPETITIVE AND STRUCTURED IN A PARALLEL WAY, IT BECOMES POETRY.

(4) LISTEN FOR NOT JUST REPEATED WORDS BUT FOR REPEATED EVENTS, OBJECTS AND IMAGES.
